




Matching Funds

Contributions designated for scholarships may be matched through relevant matching opportunities available at the time of the gift. Donors will be advised if matching gifts are available.

Scholarship Criteria & Selection

You can determine the name of the scholarship and criteria such as major, minimum GPA, county of residence, or whether the student should be required to have financial need.

We will work with you to determine the right criteria to fit your needs.

Scholarship recipients are selected by the College’s Scholarship Committee, a cross section of staff and faculty members. You will be notified in writing of each semester’s recipient. Donors are invited to attend our annual Heart of Gold Luncheon, where they can meet scholarship recipients, or the Foundation can arrange a meeting with your scholarship student.

Make a personal impact on a student by establishing a scholarship through the PHSC Foundation. Funding for scholarships is one of the Foundation's highest priority needs.

With the rising costs of tuition, financial support can be the deciding factor in a student's ability to achieve the dream of a higher education. This issue is critically important because:

- PHSC has experienced tremendous growth over the past ten years
- 70% of PHSC students require financial aid
- The average cost of tuition and books for a full-time student (12 credit hours per term) is more than \$4,000 per year. This does not include lab fees, equipment, or living expenses. These costs will only increase over the next few years.

Named Endowed Scholarships

Make a lasting impact with a named endowed scholarship. Endowments exist in perpetuity. The principal is never spent, and scholarship awards are funded through interest and capital appreciation. Your gift may be a single gift or contributed over time.


A \$15,000 minimum contribution will establish an endowment, which may be funded over multiple years. Once the minimum contribution has been met, scholarships can be awarded from the interest earned. If there is not enough interest to award a scholarship, the funds will be held in reserve for future awards.

Endowed scholarships are recognized on the College website, the online scholarship application system, and in the College Catalogue, Annual Report, and Scholarship Guidebook.

Named Annual Scholarships

Named annual scholarships are funded through an annual contribution, and allow you to make an immediate impact on a student in a significant way. Annual scholarships are considered temporary because the funding from the donor is discretionary. The typical minimum scholarship award is \$1,300 per year. Scholarships below that amount may be combined with others.

Annual Scholarships are recognized on the College website and online scholarship application system.
